Initial 30 Minute Consultation is £50 + £10 VAT = £60 (Total)

VAT will normally be applied at the current rate of 20% (to totals shown above). VAT will not be chargeable to any transaction where the client lives abroad or has no status in the UK. We will notify you whether VAT will be chargeable to your transaction on initial instruction.

• Fresh Claim – Preparation Only	£2000 + £400 VAT = £2400 (Total)
• Deportation	On a time charged basis
